## Luke 5 • Different Responses to Christ

- 1. (v.1-11) In the case of those like these disciples, It is not enough to be "familiar" with Christ; it requires forever forsaking the old life to follow Him exclusively.
- 2. (v.12-14) In the case of those like this leper, salvation produced an <u>immediate</u> change empowering the <u>immediate</u> spread of the Gospel.
- 3. (v.17-26) In the case of those like the scribes and Pharisees, they fall short of actually <u>accepting</u> Christ because they refuse to recognize themselves as <u>sinners</u>.
- 4. (v.27-28) In the case of those like the Levi, it requires <u>taking</u>
  Jesus at His <u>word</u>.
- 5. (v.29-32) To minister like Christ means to "call...sinners to repentance".
- 6. (v.36-39) To minister like Christ means to be a <u>new creation</u> who ministers as a <u>new creation</u>.
