Luke 6:20-49 • The Differences That Matter

- (v.20-26) Those grounded in <u>this</u> life know the <u>price</u> of everything but the <u>value</u> of nothing; those focused on the <u>next</u> life understand what truly has <u>value</u>.
- 2. (v.27-31) The quality of faith is proven in how we <u>treat others</u>. A quality faith is willing to sacrifice the <u>temporal</u> things of this world for the <u>eternal</u> things of the next.
- 3. (v.32-36) Loving those who hate us stems from understanding how <u>blind</u> and <u>unaware</u> they are spiritually.
- 4. (v.37-40) God proves our <u>love</u> for Him in the quality of our <u>love</u> for others.
- 5. (v.41-45) The difference in behavior between a saint and a sinner is evidenced by their behavior toward <u>people</u> and <u>possessions</u>.
- 6. (v.26-49) True Christianity is authentic to the degree it puts **God's Word** into practice. This is nowhere more visibly evident than in the quality of personal <u>relationships</u>.
