

Luke 12 • “Gospel” Defined

1. (v.1-3) We should live knowing that every thought, choice, and action will one day be exposed as either for Christ or for ourselves.
2. (v.4-7) God’s provision in this life indicates His provision for the next life.
3. (v.8-12) There is nothing in this life which can actually invoke irreparable harm.

Summary #1: This life is a precursor of the next, real life.

4. (v.13-21) At stake is something far greater than possessions or personal wealth in this life.
5. (v.22-32) Care for living for the kingdom addresses the cares of living in this life.
6. (v.33-34) “*For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also*”.

Summary #2: Set your heart on the things of the next life.

7. (v.35-38) Be “dressed in readiness” to leave this life.
8. (v.39-40) Be “dressed in readiness” for Christ’s return.
9. (v.41-48) Be “dressed in readiness” by our use of what God has given or entrusted.

Summary #3: We will be held accountable.

10. (v.49-53) There is no middle ground concerning Christ: We either confess Him as Savior or reject Him.
11. (v.54-56) The purpose of the signs of the End Times is to deepen our commitment to Christ.
12. (v.57-59) Time will run out.

Summary #4: The outcome is completely up to our personal choice.
