2. (v.3-7) *Type of Sinner*: The sinner in his <u>stupidity</u> who wanders off against all <u>common sense</u> and <u>rationality</u>.

3. (v.8-10) *Type of Sinner*: The sinner <u>unconscious</u> of his lost <u>condition</u>.

- 4. (v.11-15) *Type of Sinner*: The sinner seeking to be his own master who is knowingly and willingly estranged from God.
 - a. (v.16-19) He starts out to <u>use</u> the world but the world ends up <u>using</u> him.
 - b. (v.20-24) If he returns to God he will experience the receiving love of God.
 - c. (v.25-32) It is often not just a test of faith for the <u>sinner</u>, but for the <u>saints</u> enduring his condition.
