## Luke 17 • Wrong Spiritual States

- 1. (v.1-6) All spiritual problems can be traced back to either an issue with one's personal <u>repentance</u> because of <u>sin</u>, or in dealing with the <u>forgiveness</u> of others because of <u>sin</u>.
- 2. (v.7-10) Spiritual problems especially spiritual <u>deception</u> are often traced to someone's desire more for the <u>things</u> of this life than doing the <u>work</u> necessary to <u>obtain</u> them in the next.
- (v.11-19) There are those who squander their <u>opportunities</u> in an effort to make life better in this life. They are like the Prodigal Son, desiring to spend their <u>inheritance</u> in the here and now.
- 4. (v.20-37) Many people are not prepared for Jesus' Second Coming because they mistakenly believe that at the point of His coming everything will <a href="mailto:change">change</a>, when in reality it is the point at which it's too late to personally <a href="mailto:change">change</a> and <a href="mailto:entrance">entrance</a> is then impossible.

## **Overall Application:**

How does someone arrive at the wrong spiritual state of being unprepared for Christ's Return?

- 1. They are <u>unforgiving</u> to begin with, either in terms of their personal sin, addressing the sins of others, or both.
- 2. They see themselves as <u>unpaid</u>, someone who deserves more out of **THIS** life.
- 3. They are <u>ungrateful</u>, desiring <u>personal</u> blessings without feeling the need to render proper worship and gratitude in return.
