John 20:1-18 • The Truth of the Resurrection

1. (v.1-2) Faith can be rendered <u>ineffectual</u> when we no longer cling to the literal truth of His <u>Word</u> and instead begin to allow an earthly perspective to <u>eclipse</u> the truth.

 (v.3-10) Their faith, which had been <u>eclipsed</u> by the earthly circumstances of Christ's death, was now beginning to <u>dawn</u> a little brighter in view of the <u>evidence</u>, but was still not fully embracing the <u>Word of God</u>.

(v.11-18) It may be good to have faith that is based on solid
evidence, but the evidence should lead us to the Word which
should lead us to the Savior. The key to biblical faith is the
Word of God.

Overall Application:

<u>Historical</u> faith says, "Christ lives!"; <u>saving</u> faith says, "Christ lives in me!"
