John 20:19-31 • From Fear & Doubt to Courage & Assurance

- (v.19-23) The transformation from fear to courage was accomplished first Christ's personal <u>visit</u>, in graciously dealing with them not as their sins and behavior <u>deserved</u>, by reassuring Him with His <u>Word</u> and proof of <u>authenticity</u>, by further <u>commissioning</u> them to carry on His work in the world, and by enabling them through the <u>indwelling</u> of the Holy Spirit.
- (v.24-28) The transformation from doubt to assurance was accomplished by restoring <u>faith</u> in Christ and His <u>Word</u>; otherwise <u>faith</u> is placed in something else, most often <u>one's</u> <u>self</u>.
- (v.29-31) <u>Faith</u> in Christ as the Son of God through belief in His <u>Word</u> accomplishes the ultimate transformation from <u>death</u> to <u>life</u>.

Overall Application:

Salvation is not an act of <u>resuscitation</u>, but <u>resurrection</u> from death to life.
