Acts 2 • Ecclesiology

- (v.1-13) Man's <u>identity</u> is no longer based on language, ethnic identity, tribal identity, national identity or anything else attached to <u>physical</u> birth, but is now instead based on <u>NEW</u> birth.
- 2. (v.37-47) There MUST be a conviction of sin, a cleansing by the Holy Spirit, and an understanding that unless God loved you so much that He paid the price, you are judged and doomed to hell. Going forward there must be a turning, a ceasing from living according to the ways which doomed you in the first place.
- 3. (v.41-42) Three aspects of "devotion":
 - a. Devotion to the Word.
 - b. Devotion to **each other**.
 - c. Devotion to <u>leadership</u>.
 - d. **Doctrine** must be right for everything else to be right.
- 4. (v.43-47) Many things can only really be accomplished in a **small group** setting such as fellowship and the development of gifts.
