Romans 1:1-17 • How to Be Right with God

(v.1-7) God has a <u>purpose</u> for my life that involves both a <u>personal</u> call for the work of His kingdom and a <u>general</u> call to be holy — separated and distinct in <u>heart</u> and <u>character</u>—from the world, wholly devoted to His <u>service</u>, and His <u>service</u> only.

2. (v.8-17) Publicly and unapologetically <u>proclaiming</u> Christ and His Gospel is a visible indicator of those truly "called as <u>saints</u>"— set apart from this world as <u>holy</u> ones, <u>dedicated</u> vessels for His exclusive use.

 (v.8-17) Biblical <u>righteousness</u> is equated with biblical <u>faithfulness</u>. It the application of faith going forward after coming to the <u>cross</u>.
