Galatians 1-2:10 • Accountability

- 1. (1:1) True spiritual <u>authority</u> is not derived from men but directly from God.
- 2. (2:1) Spiritual <u>independence</u> is proven by the <u>unity</u> it produces.
- 3. (1:10) It is actually about being **personally** accountable to **God**.
- 4. (2:2) It is also about being **corporately** accountable to **God**.
- 5. (1:10) It is about pleasing God.
- 6. (2:3-7) Although working <u>independently</u>, the ministry goals of the Gospel are the <u>same</u> as other biblical ministries.
- 7. (1:11) The source of the Gospel is divine <u>revelation</u> from Christ, not human <u>institutions</u> or <u>ideas</u>.
- 8. (2:7-8) Different <u>callings</u> work toward the same unified <u>purpose</u> through Christ.
- 9. (1:15-17) Our decision to come to Christ and heed His call is independent of others' <u>feedback</u>.
- 10. (2:9) We are all <u>independently</u> saved and called, yet are <u>unified</u> by Christ in building up His kingdom through the same <u>Gospel</u>. There is only one body in Christ, therefore we are all working towards the same <u>goal</u>.
