Ephesians 2:1-10 • Leaving Our Corpse Behind

- (v.1) A spiritual corpse is the result of "<u>trespasses</u>" (a lapse from doing what we know is <u>right</u>) and "<u>sins</u>" (continued separation from God by our <u>behavior</u>).
- 2. (v.2) Three contributing factors producing a "living corpse":
 - a. "...the course of this world...": the normal working of the physical world.
 - b. "...the prince of the power of the air...": the deliberate, manipulative force at work through <u>Satan</u>.
 - c. "...the spirit...of disobedience": the unseen working of spiritual darkness.
- 3. (v.3) Unchecked, these forces cause a person to grow further apart from <u>God</u> toward the inevitable destination of God's <u>wrath</u>.
- 4. (v.4-7) The situation is reversed through <u>Christ</u> which causes God to see us as already <u>inheriting</u> the attributes of eternal salvation eternally <u>alive</u>.
- 5. (v.8-9) It is the working of God's gift through grace and faith.
- 6. (v.10) God not only sees us as already eternally living in heaven but accomplishing His word in this present life.
