## Ephesians 4-6:9 • The Christian Walk

- 1. (4:1-16) A biblical church equips the Body by the pursuit of <u>love</u> through the application of God's <u>Word</u>:
  - a. (v.12) "...the <u>equipping</u> of the saints for the work of service..."
  - b. (v.12) "...building up the body of Christ..."
  - c. (v.13) "...attain to the unity of faith..."
  - d. (v.13) "...attain...to a <u>mature</u> man...the stature which belongs to the fullness of <u>Christ</u>..."
  - e. (v.14) "...no longer...tossed here and there...by every wind of doctrine..."
  - f. (v.15) "...speaking the truth in love..."
  - g. (v.15) "...to <u>grow up</u> in all aspects into Him who is the head..."
  - h. (v.16) "...<u>fitted</u> and <u>held</u> together...according to the proper <u>working</u> of each part..."
  - i. (v.16) "...growth...building up...in love."
- 2. (4:17-32) Christians are expected to be radically different from the unsaved...
  - a. (v.22-23) "...lay aside the old self..."
  - b. (v.24) "...put on the <u>new self</u>..."
  - c. (v.25-32) Lay aside behaviors specific to the <u>old</u> self in favor of the <u>new</u> self.

- 3. (5:1-5) Christians are expected to "<u>walk in love</u>" in the character of Christ on the <u>cross</u>, thinking of <u>others</u> and hating sin which should never be <u>named</u> among believers.
- 4. (5:6-14) The Christian walk is characterized as a partnership or lifestyle in the <u>Light</u>...
  - a. (2 Co. 6:14) "...not bound together with unbelievers..."
  - b. (2 Pe. 1:4) "...partakers of the divine nature..."
  - c. (Eph. 3:6) "...partakers of the promise..."
  - d. (1 Pe. 4:13) "...share the sufferings of Christ..."
  - e. (Heb. 12:10) "...share His holiness..."
  - f. (Heb. 3:1) "...partakers of a heavenly calling..."
  - g. (1 Pe. 5:1) "...partaker also of the glory..."
- 5. (5:15-17) A Christian walk does not waste time or resources apart from God's <u>will</u>.
- 6. (5:18-6:9) Harmony and unity in our personal <u>relationships</u> proves harmony and unity in our overall <u>walk</u>.
- 7. Overall Application
  - a. To walk in unity. (4:1-16)
  - b. To walk in **purity**. (4:17-32)
  - c. To walk in <u>love</u>. (5:1-5)
  - d. To walk in the <u>Light</u>. (5:6-14)
  - e. To walk <u>carefully</u>. (5:15-17)
  - f. To walk in <u>harmony</u>. (5:18-6:9)
