Philippians 3 • The Spiritual Mind

 (v.1-11) The spiritual mind deals with each Christian's <u>past</u> and how it is resolved through the biblical working of <u>salvation</u> to accomplish through God's <u>grace</u> in Christ what can never be accomplished by <u>religion</u> alone.

2. (v.12-16) The spiritual mind deals with each Christian's <u>present</u> and how it is dealt with through the biblical working of <u>sanctification</u> in the forsaking of the <u>goals</u> of this world in pursuit of "the upward <u>call</u> of God in Christ Jesus" (v.14)

3. (v.17-21) The spiritual mind point deals with each Christians future through the biblical working of their glorification not just spiritually but, in the end, physically. The power of the resurrection which first began its work through salvation is ultimately and literally completed to "transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory". (v.21)
