Colossians 2 • Three Things to Be Aware Of

- 1. (v.1-10) Those who overcomes false teachers and their philosophies are those of "good discipline" and have "the stability of...faith in Christ"—that is, those who are consistently and faithfully putting the Word into practice.
 - a. Overcomers walk in **Christ**. (v.6)
 - b. Overcomes grow up in **Christ**. (v.7)
 - c. Overcomes make **Christ** the test. (v.8)
 - d. Overcomers draw on the fullness of Christ. (v.9-10)

 (v.11-17) The Believer who overcomes false teachers of religious legalism adheres to the reality of the fulfillment of all things through <u>Christ</u> and the <u>cross</u> rather than being distracted by over-realizing the <u>symbols</u> representing those things.

 (v.18-23) The Believer who overcomes false teachers where man-made <u>disciplines</u> are concerned holds fast to a <u>crucified</u> life which considers those worldly <u>disciplines</u> to be equally dead and useless when it comes to growth into <u>Christ the Head</u>.
