## 1 Thessalonians 2:1-13 • Definition of a True Minister

- 1. (2:1-8) A true minister preaches the Gospel regardless.
- 2. (2:3-5) A true minister does **NOT** present the Gospel...
  - a. "...from error or impurity..." (v.3)
  - b. "...by way of <u>deceit</u>..." (v.3)
  - c. "...not as pleasing to men but God..." (v.4)
- 3. (2:6-8) A true minister equally tempers the <u>truth</u> of the message by the example of <u>love</u> in their own life.
- (2:7-12) The goal of a true minister is to produce a <u>flock</u> "that may walk in a manner <u>worthy</u> of the God who calls [them]."
  (v.12)
- 5. (2:13) The proof of a true minister is flock that puts **the Word** into practice.
