## 1 Timothy 3 • New Testament Organizations

1. (v.1-7) A biblical <u>overseer</u> is someone in authority who is watching, directing, and protecting the Master's <u>interests</u>. They are closer to a <u>pastor</u> than a <u>business</u> leader.

 (v.8-13) A biblical <u>deacon</u> is specifically tasked in order to allow overseers to concentrate on their primary calling to <u>preach the</u> <u>Word</u>.

3. (v.14-16) The offices specified have roles in line with <u>familial</u> duties within the church as "the household of God" and for establishing the <u>church</u> in the world as "the pillar and support of the truth". They are supposed to produce biblical <u>godliness</u> in both our relationships with each other within the body of Christ proper and as a testimony of <u>Christ</u> to the world at large.
