1 Timothy 5-6 • Seven Kinds of People

- 1. (5:1-2) The greater issue where the <u>family of Christ</u> is concerned is the need to pursue relationships "<u>in all purity</u>".
- 2. (5:3-16) The greater issue where <u>widows</u> are concerned is the need to be "<u>beyond reproach</u>".
- 3. (5:17-25) The greater issue where <u>leadership</u> is concerned is the need to be <u>accountable</u> and <u>faithful</u>.
- 4. (6:1-2) The greater issue where <u>slaves</u> are concerned is the need to be a <u>witness</u> for the <u>Gospel</u>.
- 5. (v.6:3-5) The greater issue where <u>troublemakers</u> are concerned is the need for <u>sound doctrine</u>.
- 6. (v.6:5-19) The greater issue where the <u>rich</u> are concerned is the need to <u>use it wisely</u> for the <u>kingdom</u>.
- 7. (v.6:20-21) The greater issue where the so-called "educated" are concerned is the need to preserve the truth.

<u>Summary</u>: The first and foremost need is maintaining spiritual <u>faithfulness</u> regardless of personal <u>circumstances</u>. The obligation to meet <u>physical</u> needs is always secondary to the <u>spiritual</u>.
