Hebrews 4 • God's Rest

- (v.1-5) We can believe in God, believe in His promises, but if our walk and behavior do not conform to God's <u>Word</u>, "<u>belief</u>" never grows into "<u>faith</u>".
- 2. (v.6-11) God's rest is attained through our daily <u>obedience</u> to His Word. The future is secured by <u>obedience</u> in the present.

3. (v.12) The proof of obedience to God's Word is changed behavior.

4. (v.13) True obedience passes the test of both externally <u>visible</u> and internally <u>hidden</u> behavior.

Overall:

God's rest is presented not as a refuge of escape, but the inevitable **destination** coming from putting His Word into practice both in **this life** and for **the next life** to come.
