1 John 4:1-16 • The Bottom Line of Love

- 1. (v.1-6) Biblical love without biblical <u>truth</u> is impossible because biblical love is defined by biblical <u>truth</u>. The regenerate Believer has the foundation of "the spirit of <u>truth</u>" whereas those still in the world operate on "the spirit of <u>error</u>".
- (v.7-8) The proof that someone truly knows God is proven by their application of the <u>truth</u> of God's <u>Word</u> to such a degree that they began to take on the loving character and nature of <u>God</u>.
- 3. (v.9-11) The proof that someone has truly been transformed by the <u>cross</u> is proven by a new <u>life</u> which increasingly <u>loves</u> more and more in the character and truth of the <u>love</u> Christ expressed on that <u>cross</u>. (Make note of 1 Jn. 4:9, 2 Co. 5:15 & 1 Th. 5:9-10)
- 4. (v.12-16) God's love is <u>proclaimed</u> in His Word, <u>proved</u> at the cross, <u>perfected</u> in the Believer.

Overall Application:

- 1 Jn. 4:15—The Believer is a <u>witness</u> that Jesus Christ is God's Son.
- 1 Jn. 4:13—The Holy Spirit is a witness in each Believer.
- 1 Jn. 4:14--The application of love in the Believer <u>witnesses</u> that God is love and that He sent His Son to die for the world.
